Wauchope-Bonny Hills Surf Lifesaving Club proudly keeping our Community safe since 1958

WBHSLSC has made a massive contribution to the community and the safety of our visitors to Rainbow Beach. We can proudly say that the beach was patrolled by our members (all volunteers) for a total of 3,629.5 hours with only 6 beach closures. We conducted 11 rescues, with ages ranging from 6 to 45 years old. Our members contributed to the safety of our beach by undertaking a total of 420 preventative actions, which undoubtedly saved many lives and prevented further rescues. We recorded 13 major first aid interventions during the season, ranging from lacerations and spinal trauma to hyperthermia, fractures, and dislocations. Additionally, our members provided lifesaving assistance to our wider community, including flood rescue support and water safety at multiple events.







BONNY HILLS RURAL FIRE SERVICE

Fifteen callouts since the last post, including 5 callouts relating to motor vehicles, (sadly yet another fatality at the Houston Mitchel Dr/Pacific Hwy intersection), 6 calls to grass/bush fires, 1 ambulance assist, 1 aircraft incident where the pilot had engine problems and may need to attempt a landing on the beach (north of Lake Cathie), however (to everyone's relief) he made it back to the airport unscaved and 2 good intent calls where smoke sittings in Lake Cathie turned out to be a hazard reductions at Herons Creek. Just a reminder to property owners intending to carry out a hazard reduction or pile burn, you are required to give 24 hrs notice to your neighbours and the RFS and prevent the fire spreading to neighbouring properties.
