

The Rains Have Come



Finally, after so many months of low rainfall, we received a generous amount of rain at the end of October 2023. Bonny Hills local resident and Landcare Member, Mark Walters, measured 110mm in his rain gauge over 3 days from 25th to 27th October 2023. What a relief the rain was! Fantastic for the plants, animals, birds, reptiles and even the insects that had been suffering in the extremely conditions we were experiencing.

Unfortunately, this much needed rain was also fantastic for growth and proliferation of many weeds. As any gardener would say, the weeds never stop growing and this is especially true after good soaking rain like we received. Our Landcare team target weeds both big and small. For example by pulling out the Senna Cassia (Senna pendula var. glabrata) seedlings we tackle the problem of large numbers of weeds while they are still easy to handle. We also tackle mature Senna plants by harvesting ripe seed pods then cutting the trunk as low to the ground as possible then a tiny dose of herbicide and the job is done.

Thinking ahead to summer 2023/2024, it is highly likely that all this fast weed growth will dry out, providing extra fuel for potential bushfires.

So, if you have been thinking about doing something to help protect our native plants and our village at the same time, then perhaps you might want to join the Bonny Hills Landcare Team. There are many ways that members can contribute. Some choose to join the monthly working bees. Others prefer to choose their own target areas and work in teams of families, 2 or as solo volunteers. Some of us see weeds when we are walking around and just can't resist tackling them as we pass by.




THE POWER OF TESTAMENTARY TRUSTS FOR ADULT CHILDREN

FICTIONAL COUPLE

Meet George & Betty

They have one 1 adult child, Josh who is married to Louise. George and Betty have both died, leaving a \$1 million estate to Josh.



PROTECTION FOR GRANDKIDS

SIMPLE WILL

- There's a high likelihood that Josh's Will leaves everything to Louise.
- If Josh later dies and Louise repartners, there's no certainty that George and Betty's inheritance will end up in the hands of Josh and Louise's kids. The inheritance is at the mercy of Louise's Will and could all go to Louise's new spouse or future children.

TESTAMENTARY TRUST

- If Josh receives the inheritance via a testamentary trust for Josh and his kids, then Josh's Will (and therefore Louise's Will) is irrelevant in relation to the inheritance from George and Betty.
- The inheritance stays in a protected testamentary trust environment for the benefit of Josh's kids after Josh dies and can be managed for his kids by trusted family or friends.

ASSET PROTECTION

SIMPLE WILL

- The inheritance is automatically part of the property pool in family law proceedings and there's not much Josh can do to protect it if Josh goes through a relationship breakdown with Louise.
- The same applies if Josh is running a business or is in a highrisk occupation and is sued by a creditor or employee, for example.

TESTAMENTARY TRUST

- The inheritance is NOT automatically part of the property pool in family law proceedings if Josh and Louise break up.
- The trust puts Josh on the front foot and gives him a lot more options to protect the inheritance.
- The inheritance is protected if Josh is declared bankrupt.

TAX FREE INCOME

A \$1 million investment can earn a 5% average annual return. This means \$50,000 extra income can be generated by Betty and George's inheritance each and every year.

SIMPLE WILL

- The income would be taxed in Josh's tax return on top of his marginal tax rate (potentially placing him in a higher tax bracket).
- Josh pays for his kid's school fees, lessons etc. with his after tax income.

TESTAMENTARY TRUST

- 22k tax free income per child each and every year.
- Josh pays for his kid's school fees, medical bills, sports lessons etc. with TAX FREE income.
- medical bills, sports Josh doesn't have to dip into capital to fund his kid's living expenses!



Always a very busy time for the brigade (just prior the the introduction of fire permits) with most of the calls to grass fires where they have escaped into neighbouring property. One of note where quite a number of Brigades were responded to a grass fire near Herons Creek which resulted in 3 machinery sheds catching fire and a number of old cars also lost.

Now is the time to prepare your homes for the coming fire season, keep your gutters clear of leaves, trim back trees and bushes and remove combustibles from around your home, make sure your garden hoses and fittings are usable and most importantly have a fire plan.


